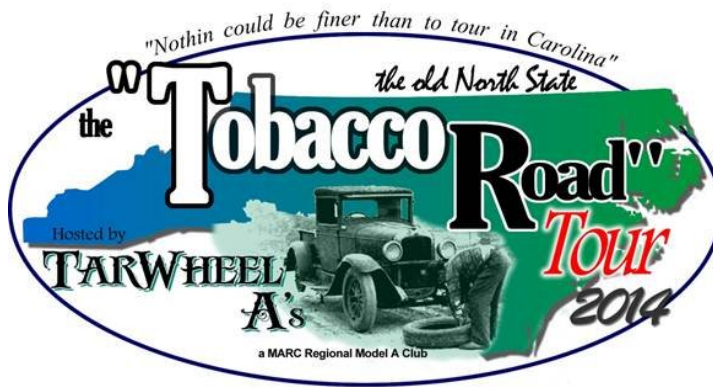

Tour	Destination / Cost / Description (Fees are per person.)	Distance (RT)
1	Tarboro: This scenic drive takes you to Tarboro, where, in the heart of the city's 45 acre historic district, you'll see one of the two remaining, original, Town Commons in the U.S. This tour also takes you to see several museums, a working cotton mill, the house of artist Hobson Pittman, and the Quigless Center, one of the earliest African-American medical centers. No fee for museum & house tours (donations are accepted). Lunch on your own at local restaurants.	170
2	Raleigh: This tour takes you to downtown Raleigh to visit the NC History Museum with its well-reviewed "Story Of North Carolina" exhibit, and a "Behind the Scenes" tour to the lower level work shops where items are cleaned, restored, and prepared for exhibition. Then it's on to the Mordecai Park historic district, which includes the birthplace of President Andrew Johnson. This tour finishes up at Yates Mill Pond, a working gristmill museum. Guided Tour of Mordecai Park sites- \$3 Yates Mill entry \$5. Lunch on your own at local restaurants.	20
3	Durham / On this tour, you will visit three spectacular Duke University sites, the beautiful and tranquil Sarah P. Duke Gardens, the recently opened Nasher Art Museum (Museum open Tuesday only), and the beautiful, neo-gothic Duke Chapel. Nasher Museum admission \$5. Lunch options include Terrace Café in the gardens, nearby restaurants, or pack your own picnic.	70
4	Durham Bulls & RTP: This tour takes you to another side of Durham to see the Durham Athletic Park, famous for its use in the movie Bull Durham, the Durham Bulls Athletic Park, the new home of the Durham Bulls, and concludes with a drive into Research Triangle Park for a short video presentation about this dynamic, 7000 acre campus of innovation. No fee. Lunch on your own at local restaurants.	60
5	Kenly & Selma: On this tour, you'll see the working gristmill of the Atkinson Milling Company, (buy some authentic grits!). The next stop is the Tobacco Farm Life Museum in Kenly. Last stop is Selma for lunch and antiques shopping. Tobacco Life Museum \$8/person, Lunch on your own at local restaurants.	110
6	Randleman Richard Petty Garage, Museum & House: This tour takes you to see Richard Petty's Museum and Garage, famous nationwide for its roots in the early days of NASCAR, America's fastest growing sport. You'll see cars and trophies and all manner of memorabilia, and you'll also have the opportunity to visit Richard's garage where he builds modern racecars. Museum admission \$6, Garage, House & Museum \$10.	160
7	Kinston: CSS Neuse Replica & Museum, Richard Caswell Museum Step back into history for a visit to one of the most dynamic and formative eras of our nation with a visit to the CSS Neuse museum where you'll see a replica of the CSS Neuse ironclad and learn about life and battle on this vessel. Also on this tour is the Richard Caswell museum, devoted to the life of this Revolutionary War hero who became North Carolina's first elected governor. No fee for museums. Lunch on your own at local restaurants.	200
8	Franklinton & Zebulon: Private car collections of Bob Schaaf (Franklinton) and Mike Leith (Zebulon). Bob has a fine collection of low-production vehicles, with a focus on Woodies and finned vehicles from 1930 to 1962. Mike and his brother Dave currently have about 200 vehicles in their collection. They began collecting cars traded in at their dealership, selecting choice examples of all-original vehicles from the 30's, 40's, 50's and early 60's. No fees. Lunch on your own at local restaurants.	90
Grand Tour	Carthage: 100 Years of Progress is a walk down memory lane. Here you will find tractors of all kinds — John Deeres, International Harvesters, Rumleys, Massey Ferguson, etc.; prairie tractors, steam engines, hit-and-miss engines, implements, vintage automobiles, a saw mill and a pioneer village to wander through. Entry fee \$15 per person, lunch included.	120
